

## Overnight Camp Packing List for Camp Fire Camp Toccoa

The following items are suggested to ensure a safe and comfortable camp experience for your camper. Please do not send new or expensive clothing. Camp Fire Camp Toccoa activities take place outdoors; our hope is for campers to enjoy the freedom of not worrying about stains or the impact of "Georgia Red Clay!" Each item is to be clearly marked with a permanent marker or sewn-on tags including the campers first and last name. Camp Fire Camp Toccoa is not responsible for loss of damage to personal items/equipment. The temperature at camp usually allows for shorts and t-shirts during the day. Slightly warm clothing may be recommended during the vents or on rainy days.

### Luggage

Your camper will have a short walk to their cabin/living area so please choose luggage with this in mind. Footlockers or large plastic containers, with handles, work well for packing. Camp Fire Camp Toccoa has a rough terrain; luggage with wheels is not recommended. We recommend that campers assist with packing their luggage so they know what items they have, where they are, etc.

**Keep in mind, campers will need enough clothes for at least one change of clothes per day. The weather is often a factor and campers need extra clothes on rainy day.**

2 pair of tennis shoes (required)	Towels and washcloths
7-10 pair of shorts	Towel for pool
7-10 shirts	Personal toiletry articles
2-3 pair of jeans	Sleeping bag for outdoor use
10-12 pair of socks	2 twin *flat* sheets (required)
Bathing Suit (1 piece for females)	2 hard plastic or metal water bottles
Pajamas	Flashlight with extra batteries
10-12 pair of underwear	Sunscreen – non aerosol preferred
Jacket or sweatshirt	Bug spray – non aerosol preferred
Laundry bag	Pillow with pillowcase
Raincoat or poncho	Shower shoes or flip flops
	Everyday use backpack

Other items: 7 X 6 waterproof ground tarp of plastic (to lay on the ground on camp out night). Pre-addressed and stamped envelopes, camping utensils (plastic bowl, spoon, fork), camera (no digital camera), books, crossword puzzles, card games, small musical instruments, stuffed animals, personal fan (battery operated). \*Voyager campers will have a sort hike while carrying their items to camp out (sleeping bag, clothing, camping utensils, etc.), please send a backpack that will accommodate these items. All other campers will use a backpack for everyday use (walking to and from the pool, barn, etc).
