**Reminder:**

- **Campers should not bring the following:** Campers are not permitted to have food, candy, chewing gum, animals and pets, radios, CD players, MP3 players, iPods, pocket knives, weapons, fireworks, personal sports equipment, video games, pagers, cell phones, or other personal computer devices and vehicles. If brought, these items will be sent home or retained at camp until they can be picked up.

- Each camper is responsible for his or her own belongings.

The wind is a primary concern - please send your camper with a wind resistant/hard-shelled jacket. If your camper only has fleece or cotton, a rain coat over top will help reduce the effects of the wind.

The cabins and bathhouses are heated and will be toasty BUT unfortunately not connected.

Campers will have to travel a short distance outdoors from the cabins to the bathhouse, please keep this in mind when packing. You may choose to send a warm robe and clog shoes or boots that can be easily slipped on over socks for late night bathroom trips.

Medication is not to be stored in camper's luggage! Please see the parent handbook for information on medication. If medication found in luggage, the parent/guardian will be notified and the medication will not be administered to the camper throughout the weekend.
